### **UNLICENSED PRACTICE IS A CONCERN**

Several contractors have come to the attention of the Montana Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors. These contractors are being investigated for unlicensed practice. The Montana Code Annotated (MCA) offers specific language on this subject, as the following excerpts show:

#### **37-67-101 Definitions:**

(6) (a) "Practice of engineering" means:

(i) any service or creative work the adequate performance of which requires engineering education, training, and experience in the application of special knowledge of the mathematical, physical, and engineering sciences to the services or creative work as consultation, investigation, evaluation, planning and design of engineering works and systems, planning the use of water, teaching of advanced engineering subjects, engineering surveys, and the inspection of construction for the purpose of ensuring compliance with drawings and specifications;

(ii) any of the functions described in subsection (6)(a)(i) that embrace the services or work, either public or private, in connection with any utilities, structures, buildings, machines, equipment, processes, work systems, projects, and industrial or consumer products or equipment of mechanical, electrical, hydraulic, pneumatic, or thermal nature insofar as they involve safeguarding life, health, or property.

(b) The term includes other professional services necessary to the planning, progress, and completion of any engineering services.

(c) The term does not include the work ordinarily performed by persons who operate or maintain machinery or equipment, communication lines, signal circuits, electric power lines, or pipelines.

### **37-67-301. License required to practice or offer to practice.**

In order to safeguard life, health, and property and to promote the public welfare, a person in either a public or private capacity practicing or offering to practice engineering or land surveying is required to submit evidence that the person is qualified to practice and is licensed as provided in this chapter. It is unlawful for a person to practice or to offer to practice in this state engineering or land surveying or to use in connection with the person's name or otherwise assume, use, or advertise any title or description tending to convey the impression that the person is a professional engineer or a professional land surveyor unless the person has been licensed under the provisions of this chapter.

These laws exist "In order to safeguard life, health, and property and to promote the public welfare," {MCA 37-67-301}. Although many buildings may have been built over the years without the use of an engineer, it becomes important to have the work done by a professional when we remember that a mistake in the design of any of the systems (Structural, Electrical, Mechanical, Plumbing, or Site Civil) can result in a loss of property, an injury, or in extreme cases, even in the loss of life. **Licensure is the only way to unequivocally assign responsibility and accountability for the systems.** This is why we must make sure that only licensed professionals provide these design services.

It is the intent of the Montana Board to actively investigate the allegations of unlicensed practice. To this end, the Montana Board solicits your input about the issue and information concerning potential occurrences of unlicensed practice.

### **CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORIZATIONS**

Please be aware that if you are a sole proprietorship, firm, partnership or corporation engaged in the practice of engineering or the practice of land surveying in Montana that you or the firm, partnership or corporation are required to obtain a certification of authorization from the board office and must have a professional engineer or professional land surveyor in residence who is in responsible charge of the engineering or land surveying work conducted in the office or place of business. This is in accordance with 37-67-320 MCA. You can obtain an application for certificate of authorization on our website.

# UPDATE TO MONTANA'S SUBDIVISION AND SURVEYING LAWS & REGULATIONS

The newest edition of *Montana's Subdivision and Surveying Laws and Regulations 19<sup>th</sup> Edition* was printed in November 2006 and mailed out in January 2007. This was a concerted effort by the Joint Powers Insurance Authority of the Montana Association of Counties, the Montana League of Cities and Towns, the Department of Labor and Industry – Montana Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors, and the Department of Commerce Community Development Division. The Department of Labor and Industry and the Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors wants to thank those that worked together making this document available to the public, regulators, and professionals.

One important contributor to this publication was Ms. Myra Shultz, Attorney at Law, whom updated the Montana Subdivision Law Digest section. This section had not been updated since the March 2000 18<sup>th</sup> Edition.

Copies of the 19<sup>th</sup> Edition were mailed to all active licensed professional land surveyors and professional engineer surveyors. In addition, it was distributed to all the clerk and recorders offices, incorporated cities & towns, and county officials. We have received numerous positive comments on this publication.

Because of the cost to produce each book and the fact that the material becomes dated after each rule change or legislative session, limited numbers were produced. ## COMPLAINT REPORT

The Board has received 26 new complaints since May 2006. Below is a brief summary of those matters:

### **Unlicensed Practice:**

1 unlicensed complaint was reviewed by the full board for unlicensed practice. The board found reasonable cause to believe that statutes and rules were violated.

The board issued a Cease and Desist Order against Mr. Carl Posewitz, Architect from Missoula, Montana.

### **Unprofessional conduct:**

1 Default Order issued. Legal document issued by the Adjudication Panel to a Respondent for failure to respond to the Notice requesting a Hearing. Please see the disciplinary report.

### **Revocation:**

1 license revoked. Please see the disciplinary report.

### **License Denials:**

3 applicants were reviewed and denied licensure.

### **Contested Cases:**

6 Contested Case Hearings. A legal proceeding (outside the judicial process) before an appointed Hearing Examiner (similar to a judge)

### **Investigations:**

3 Investigations Assigned. An investigation entails the gathering of facts and information surrounding allegations listed in a complaint, depending on the nature of the matter, an investigation can take 6 to 18 months to complete.

### **Tabled:**

2 complaint matters tabled. Matters tabled pending additional information from the respondent.

### **Dismissed complaints:**

2 complaints reviewed by the Board Screening Panel were dismissed without prejudice. The Screening Panel found no reasonable cause to believe that the statutes or rules were violated. The Board may again consider complaints dismissed without prejudice in the future if there is another complaint of similar nature filed against the Respondent.

7 complaints reviewed by the Board Screening Panel were dismissed with prejudice. The Screening Panel found no reasonable cause to believe that the statutes or rules were violated. Complaints dismissed with prejudice cannot be revisited again.

**Complaints dismissed with or without prejudice are not disclosed to the public nor are the contents of dismissed complaint public information.**

Notices of proposed Board action and Final Orders are considered public information and are available upon written request.

## COMPLIANCE

### What is the Purpose of the Board's Screening Panel? By Vicki Bair

As a professional, you may ask what is the purpose of the Board's Screening Panel? If a complaint is filed against a licensee with the Board, the Screening Panel is charged with determining the preliminary action to be taken on the matter. The Screening Panel consists of Board members who do not serve on the Adjudication Panel, which are those remaining members of the Board.

After a Screening Panel has considered a complaint and the licensee's response to the complaint, the Screening Panel can choose from the following options: request an investigation, determine whether or not reasonable cause exists for issuance of a Notice of Proposed Board Action, dismiss the complaint with or without prejudice and in some cases issue a Letter of Instruction or a warning to the licensee.

If the Screening Panel finds reasonable cause to believe a licensee has violated statutes/ and or rules, the Department Prosecuting Attorney serves a Notice of Proposed Board Action and the Opportunity for a Hearing. Once a Notice is issued to the licensee, the Notice becomes public information and may be disclosed to the public.

A licensee has twenty days in which to contest the proposed action and request an administrative hearing. If the licensee is offered a Stipulation for settlement along with the Notice, he or she has twenty days from the receipt of the Notice to sign, date and return the Stipulation, request a hearing, or work with the Department Prosecuting Attorney for a possible settlement. A signed Proposed Stipulation proceeds to the Adjudication Panel for approval or rejection. If approved, it becomes part of the Final Order, which is a legal document signed by the Presiding Officer of the Adjudication Panel indicating the panel has accepted the settlement or has adopted the Proposed Order of the Hearing Examiner.

## DISCIPLINARY REPORT

### Steve R Lennis, Professional Engineer # 14527 Florence MT

Suspended License - Mr. Lennis had entered into a written contract to do a subdivision project on or about March 28, 2003. The Screening Panel found reasonable cause to believe that Mr. Lennis accepted a subdivision project that exceeded the Licensee's level of competence and, as such, committed unprofessional conduct pursuant to Sections 37-1-31MCA, 37-67-331(1)(d) MCA, ARM 24.183.2203 and subjects Mr. Lennis to the sanctions provided in Section 37-1-312 MCA.

The Adjudication Panel signed the Order Granting Default and Final Order stating the license is revoked as of May 17, 2007.
